

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SANITARY DISTRICT OF
DECATUR PRETREATMENT ORDINANCE NUMBER 94-01

BY AMENDING SECTION 600.100

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE

SANITARY DISTRICT OF DECATUR, MACON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

The Sanitary District of Decatur Pretreatment Ordinance Number 94-01 is hereby amended by amending Section 100.100 Penalties and Costs as follows:

Any Industrial User who is found to have violated an Order of the POTW or who has failed to comply with any provision of this Ordinance and the Orders, Rules and Regulations Wastewater Discharge Permits issued hereunder, shall be fined an amount not less than One Thousand dollars for each violation. For the purpose of this section, each day in which any such violations shall occur, shall be deemed a separate violation and a separate violation shall be deemed to have occurred for each constituent which has limitations listed in Part 300 of this Ordinance found to exceed the limits established in this Ordinance during any such day. In addition to the penalties provided herein, the POTW may recover reasonable attorney's fee, court costs, court reporter fees and other expenses of litigation by appropriate suit at law against the person found to have violated this Ordinance or the Orders, Rules, Regulations and Permits issued hereunder.

To:

Any Industrial User who is found to have violated an Order of the POTW or who has failed to comply with any provision of this Ordinance and the Orders, Rules and Regulations and Wastewater Discharge Permits issued hereunder, may be fined an amount not less than One Thousand dollars for each violation. For the purpose of this section, each day in which any such violations shall occur, shall be deemed a separate violation and a separate violation shall be deemed to have occurred for each constituent which has limitations listed in Part 300 of this Ordinance found to exceed the limits established in this Ordinance during any such day.
